

2017 Hardeeville Catfish Festival Parade

Rules and Route Instructions:

Please pay close attention at all times! We need a safe and festive parade!!

- We strongly encourage you to have someone walking along side of your float to disburse candy. A child running out into the street to collect candy thrown from a float is extremely dangerous!
- Dangerous maneuvers such as tire squealing and wheelies are forbidden. Please refrain from wide weaving throughout the travel lanes.
- Leave space between your entry and the person in front of you! People from the crowd may randomly want to cross the street. Watch for this behavior!
- We prefer drivers have a passenger to help watch the rear of your vehicle so that the driver can concentrate on the front.
- Recognition for categories of floats, and groups will be distributed after the parade at the main stage at noon. Judges decisions are final.

We have returned to an old favorite for the parade route.

Please enter the line-up area from Paynesville Road. This will automatically have you going in the correct direction and avoid lots of traffic problems.

- Line up would begin on Hummingbird Lane (S-27-356) (Beside the old Shoney's)
- From here it would turn left on to Hwy. 17 North to Main Street
- At this intersection the parade will turn right onto Main Street (SC Hwy 46)
- The parade will disperse after the intersection of Randall Street and Main Street on Main Street.
